

STATEMENT DEFINITIONS

What all the columns in the table mean:

Period No – is the month that the charge for your home or any payment is added to your rent account.

Date – is the actual date the charge or payment is added to your rent account.

Description – this details, what type of charge or payment is added to your rent account.

Charges – this is the amount of money that is added to your rent account.

Adjustments – this is for Orwell purposes only and is for us to make sure that your rent account is correct.

Payments - this is any money that Orwell has received for your rent account.

Balance – this is the amount of money owing after all charges and payments have been added to your rent account

AR – means an arrear or debt.

CR – means a credit.

0.00 CR – means there is nothing left to pay for this period.
