### Rosh Hashanah

This evening marks the start of Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year, a time of celebration and introspection.

The two days of Rosh Hashanah usher in the Ten Days of Repentance (Aseret Yemei Teshuvah), also known as the Days of Awe (Yamim Noraim), which culminates in the major fast day of Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement.

During this two-day festival, families will attend the synagogue, eat certain foods such as pomegranates, honey and apples, and blow a horn call a shofar, which signals the start of the Days of Awe.
